# A FEW TIPS TO HELP YOU GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR BIBLE STUDY SESSIONS

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**1** You may want to purchase a new Bible for this experience. A translation is recommended (KJV, NKJV, ASV, NIV, etc.) rather than a paraphrase (Living Bible, Clear Word). If you plan to make notes in your Bible, you might consider one with large margins.

Try to consistently use the same color, so next year you can change colors and compare.

**2** Wednesdays are highlighted in orange for each week. There are note areas on the right section of the calendar. Each week has space for questions or topics you'd like to talk about at that Bible study meeting.

**3** Remember the purpose for reading each day is to listen to what God is saying to you. Don't get caught up in all the details and things you may not completely understand, just keep reading. As you are reading, mark any verses that seem to stand out or speak to you. When you are finished reading the passages for the day, take a few moments to reflect on some simple questions:

**WHAT IS GOD SAYING TO ME THROUGH WHAT I HAVE READ? IS THERE A LESSON I CAN LEARN THAT APPLIES TO SOME SITUATION I AM GOING THROUGH? IS THERE SOME PROMISE I CAN CLAIM?**

The acronym SOAP is helpful as you are reading:

- (S) Read the Scripture
- (O) Make Observations
- (A) What is the Application to my Life?
- (P) Pray for a Renewed Heart
